Rules for Eligibility

The Directors reserve the right to use their discretion in determining the eligibility of an application and their decision will be final.

Timetable

- Branch examinations will be conducted between Saturday 7 August and Saturday 4 September 2010 at times and venues to be selected by Branch Examiners.
- The winner will attend the MLAA 2010 Lock & Security Expo to be held at the Jupiters Hotel & Casino, Gold Coast, QLD between 30 September and 2 October 2010 to receive his/her award.

Payment of Expenses

- Travelling, accommodation and meal expenses incurred for Branch level testing will be the responsibility of the applicant and/or the employer.
- Travelling, accommodation and meal expenses incurred by the winner to attend the MLAA 2010 Lock & Key Expo, Gold Coast, QLD to receive the award will be the responsibility of the Association.

Prizes

- Applicants who pass either the Practical or Master Keying competency test at the level required for admission to the Association as an Individual Member at either the Master or General level will receive a certificate acknowledging this achievement and will not be required to re-sit that test when making an application to join the Association.
- Applicants who pass both tests at the level required for admission as an Individual Member at either the Master or General level will be admitted as such a Member without payment of fees for the year ended 30 June, 2010.
- Applicants who pass both tests at the level required for admission as an Individual Member Master Locksmith will be eligible for consideration as the winner.
- The person who achieves the highest mark in each Branch and who qualifies for admission as an Individual Member Master Locksmith will receive a Certificate of Achievement.
- In addition to the all expenses paid trip to the MLAA 2010 Lock & Security Expo, QLD to receive the award, the Association will present the winner with a plaque recognising his/her achievement.
